

## 1. R. v. Roxanne Bonany Arraignment

FRIDAY, MAY 14, 2021

	CLERK OF THE COURT: Ms. Bonany, can you hear me	
	okay, this is the clerk speaking?	
5	ROXANNE BONANY: Yes, I can.	
	CLERK OF THE COURT: Is your date of birth	
	October 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 1975?	
	ROXANNE BONANY: Yes.	
	CLERK OF THE COURT: Thank you. Roxanne Bonany,	
10	you stand charged with on or about the $1^{st}$ day of	
	June in the year 2020 and the $30^{th}$ day of June in	
	the year 2020, at the City of Greater Sudbury in	
	the said Region, did by word of mouth knowingly	
	utter a threat to <b>Complainant ID</b> , to cause bodily	
15	harm to <b>Complainant</b> , I will spell the last	
	name, Complainant , contrary to s. 264.1(1)(a)	
	of the <u>Criminal Code of Canada</u> . Do you	
	understand this charge?	
	ROXANNE BONANY: Yes, I do.	
20	CLERK OF THE COURT: And to this charge, how do	
	you plead, guilty or not guilty?	
	ROXANNE BONANY: Guilty.	
	THE COURT: Thank you. At this point I will hear	
	the facts.	
25	MR. KIM: Yes, thank you, Your Honour. On June	
	the 8 <sup>th</sup> , 2020 at 10:51 in the morning the police	
	received a call from a complainant, a woman by	
	the name of Complainant ID	
30	who happens to be an immigrant from Kenya with	
	her young children. They resided at the time in	
	Address , next door neighbours to Ms.	
	Bonany. Complainant indicated to police that her	

neighbour, Ms. Bonany, had just came home with a knife, stating that she was going to kill her. She had just told her that she bought the knife and had returned back to her residence. The caller at the time the complainant did not actually know Ms. Bonany by name. She described this individual as residing at Address in Sudbury, an unknown knife, having a large knife, described in her statement to be the length of her arm. Reference was made to several racial slurs and comments made over the past week leading up to this particular incident. The police had to indicate to the complainant that she is safe, and the police were dispatched immediately. The complainant did describe Ms. Bonany to be in her forties with three young daughters and reference were made to further comments.

When police attended approximately five minutes later, Constable Lawrence arrived on the scene with Constable Troskowski. The officers spoke to the complainant who indicated that her direct neighbour shares a driveway with her at

Address and there has been some conflict over the past little while, leading up to this particular incident on June the 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020. For example, there was some conflict with respect to the complainant receiving instructions from Ms. Bonany to clearly not cross over into her part of the - into the accused's part of the driveway, and further racist comments that I will expand on

further.

When police were speaking to the complainant, complainant was visibly upset. She was crying while she was speaking to police officers and indicated that she was experiencing ongoing issues from Ms. Bonany. She continued to make racist remarks to herself, and her children and those comments were expanded in a statement provided to police.

On this particular day she was outside her car boosting her battery, she was just dealing with some car issues, and Ms. Bonany returned back from shopping with her daughters and then approached the complainant's door and tapped on the door and pointed in a knife, or it's visibly referred to a knife that she was holding in her hands and she said, "This knife I just bought for you.", or something to the effect of you see this knife, I bought it specifically for you. And she indicated that this was in the context of further comments made by Ms. Bonany to her and her children.

Again, **Complainant** is an immigrant from Kenya, she is black, and comments were made by Ms. Bonany that were racist in nature, such as "fuck you" and go back, "you black kids go back to your country", "black nigger". And according to complainant these were repeated statements that were made to her by Ms. Bonany after she had - after the complainant had moved into Sudbury housing as

a next-door neighbour. Those racist comments commenced from August 2019 and continued up until this particular incident on June the 8<sup>th</sup> of 2020.

So this particular incident was believed to be the, perhaps the peak that resulted in the police having to intervene with criminal charges. Suffice it to say, the week prior there was a neighbour dispute where the complainant, along with her friend, another immigrant from Nigeria, confronted Ms. Bonany with respect to some racist comments that they perceived to have been made to their children with respect to their skin colour. That prompted the police to be called by Ms. Bonany. No charges were laid against either side, it was deemed to be a verbal dispute.

Subsequent to this incident Ms. Bonany was charged and arrested with the offences before the court, and Sudbury Housing was already engaged in an investigation and their own proceedings with respect to Ms. Bonany for other issues, and I will describe them later. Essentially those are the facts of this incident.

MR. GAUTHIER: I have instructions from my client to accept those facts.

THE COURT: Therefore, based on the facts that I have heard, I will be making a finding of guilt with regards to the charge that Ms. Bonany pled to.
